After Winter Break we will be offering some optional ACT prep opportunities for our students. Our statewide assessment for juniors is in early March, and these sessions will help students become familiar with the unique style of test they will be taking. New this year, our freshman and sophomore students will be taking the PreACT as part of their statewide assessment (replacing ACT Aspire). This test is an abbreviated version of the ACT, but comes with many of the same question styles and strategies found on the ACT. Students interested in these prep sessions should stay tuned to announcements or stop into student services after Winter Break. We will be having our ACT bootcamp again this year for all students and some ELT activities to make sure all students are prepared for theses upcoming tests.

Finally, I want to wish everyone a very Merry Christmas and happy holidays. In an effort to make sure that everyone is able to enjoy the holidays, please know that Berlin High School and Berlin Area School District have resources available to help anyone going through a difficult time. We want to make sure that there is food on the table and gifts under the tree for everyone. We also recognize that this can be a very stressful time of year, so if any <u>student or family is needing mental</u> <u>health support, we can be of assistance</u> <u>as well</u>.
