#### A MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear BHS Families.

Normally, my monthly note to you is highlighting the events upcoming in the month ahead. While there is plenty going on in November (see other areas of this newsletter), I am taking this opportunity to address a serious issue affecting many students across the country.

My main concern as a principal is the safety and wellbeing of your children while at school. As a parent myself, I know that one of the hardest things to do is to entrust other adults with the responsibility of keeping our own children safé. It takes strong communication and partnership between the school and the family to most effectively provide a safe learning environment.

In recent years, this country has experienced an increase in the use of some legal and illegal drugs. This has affected adults, children, and families. Our community has likewise seen an increase in the use of these drugs and sometimes student possession and use stairwells, and locker rooms where at school. Schools across the country are working to educate our students and families to help reduce the use of these substances.

The most common drug use as of late involves THC, the chemical that's primarily responsible for the effects of marijuana. A variant known as Delta-8 THC is sold by gas stations and vape shops (must be 21 to purchase), so our students have easier access to this chemical than ever before. The THC variant Delta-8 often can be found in a vaping device that looks similar to a nicotine vaping device, but it can also be found in wax and gummy form. Regardless of your personal stance on THC, the fact remains that it is both

illegal and against school policy for minors to possess or use THC in any form at school. According to our Secondary Code of Conduct, THC possession is a 'Level 4' violation.

We want to prevent THC and any other illegal chemicals from coming into our building, but we need your help as caregivers. Please help by having conversations with your children; acting on suspicions by periodically checking your child's belongings, bedroom, or vehicle; and keeping close watch on items you may use or possess so they aren't accessible by your children. Finally, it is important to keep an open dialogue with your children about who they are hanging out with and where they are going.

At school, we begin by taking an educational stance, and have units in our health curriculum around substance use and abuse. We are actively looking at adding to our curriculum. In addition, as is common in other school districts, staff actively monitor areas like restrooms, students are most likely to use or distribute these types of substances. We also work with local law enforcement to help conduct school searches.

Again, our goal is to provide a safe environment for all of our students, and we need your help. Should you need additional information on addiction, THC, or any other substance, please feel free to reach out and we can connect you with the appropriate resources. Thank you for your support.


